Dear Parents and Carers,

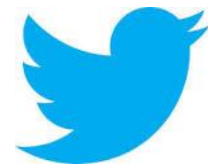

Please remember to give the school at least one week's notice if your child decides to change from packed lunches onto school lunches or back the other way. Cash or cheques are welcome – cheques payable to Cheshire East Borough Council please. We cannot bank cheques for lunches if they are addressed to the school address rather than CEC's so they will be returned and alternative payment requested. Don't forget that our menus are also available on the school website so children can see what is on offer each day.

Healthy snacks are available from our cook Janis at a cost of 20p per day. Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school every day. Water is available to the children all day and we encourage them to drink when they need to.

The cost of lunches will rise to £2.50 per day in September which reflects the rising charge to the school by Cheshire Catering.

A few uniform reminders for the new school year:

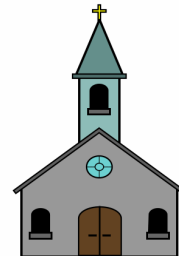


- School shoes should be black for boys and girls
- Girls' socks should be white and boys' socks should be grey
- Children are welcome to return to school in their winter or summer uniform depending on how warm it is when term starts again
- Only stud earrings should be worn and these should be removed or covered for PE
- Girls with long hair should have it tied up every day with a plain bobble, this really helps to halt the spread of head lice. Please do not wear ornate flowery clips and hairbands
- All uniform should be named. Unnamed lost property will be disposed of termly or sold as second hand uniform
- All children should have the correct PE kit in school. Children will not be permitted to borrow or share kit for hygiene reasons and will miss both their PE lesson and a playtime if they do not have the correct clothing in school
- From September 2016 children should be wearing our new uniform – green polo shirts and knitted jumpers / cardigans – and green PE t shirts with black shorts
- Nail varnish or make up is not permitted
