Dear Parents and Carers,

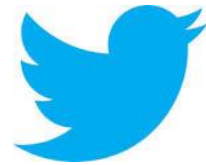
The year seems to be speeding by so far and has been very busy with lots of amazing experiences and great learning opportunities for our children.

Healthy snacks are available from our cook Liz at a cost of 20p per day. Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school every day. Water is available to the children all day and we encourage them to drink when they need to.

A few uniform reminders for summer:

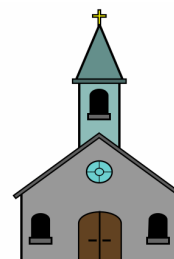


- School shoes should be black for boys and girls
- Girls' socks should be white or grey and boys' socks should be grey. Tights should be grey
- Only stud earrings should be worn and these should be removed or covered for PE
- Girls with long hair should have it tied up every day with a plain bobble, this really helps to halt the spread of head lice. Please do not wear ornate flowery clips and hairbands
- All uniform should be named. Unnamed lost property will be disposed of termly or sold as second hand uniform
- **All children should have the correct PE kit in school.** Children will not be permitted to borrow or share kit for hygiene reasons and will miss both their PE lesson and a playtime if they do not have the correct clothing in school
- Nail varnish or make up is not permitted
- Sun hats, sunglasses and sun-cream should be sent in on warm days
