Our next Big Project



We want to resurface the outdoor play area using soft-pour rubber so that the children can safely enjoy it all year round, in all weathers. Being able to use all of the outdoor features will increase pupils' fitness and time spent on physical activity, help them to learn about nature, the environment and sustainability and ensure that we are able to continue to offer a broad and enriched curriculum to all children in our care. This has been quoted as £20,000-£25,000 but we are hoping to complete this in stages, as it may take around 4 years to fundraise for the total area.

We are fortunate enough to have been chosen as one of the Co-op's good local causes and will receive community funding for this (April-Oct 2017). Hopefully we will be able to re-apply in 2018.
