School Development Priorities 2017-18

Effectiveness of Leadership and Management

- Review and evaluate leadership roles, responsibilities and practices across the school, including succession planning for key roles
- Monitor and develop leadership opportunities for new and existing staff with a specific focus on positively addressing staff workload

Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment

- Review and refine the organisation of provision and assessment systems for pupils with SEND
- Review and revise the systems in place for the assessment of non-core subjects

Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare

- Review and improve provision and support for pupils' emotional / mental health and resilience (Emotionally Healthy Schools Project)
- Support and further develop boys' capacity to articulate emotions and feelings

Outcomes for Pupils

- Improve parental engagement in developing positive reading habits, particularly for low attaining pupils and those with SEND, so that more attain the expected standard in reading
- Improve outcomes in writing by extending time allocated to drafting and editing, and embedding improvements in pupils' spelling
