



In 2016, we were able to provide a sack of toys to 1,900 children in the Manchester and Cheshire area. Working with social workers, schools and various drop-in centres, the Appeal is provided with lists of families, who need help to ensure that their children receive something at Christmas. The Toy Appeal can only take requests for toy sacks via the above routes.

Each toy sack is made specifically for each child, based on their age, gender and any special needs they may have.

To date, we have provided 4,112 toy sacks to underprivileged children in the Manchester and Cheshire area. In our 5th year, we are hoping to be able to provide toy sacks to 4,000 children. This can only be achieved with your support.

We provide toys to children, regardless of race, religion and gender.

On average each child will receive 8 carefully selected different items in their toy sack.

1. Main present appropriate to the child's age
2. Stocking fillers
3. Board game or puzzle
4. Books
5. Arts & crafts items
6. Teddy (age appropriate)

7. Ball / Sports item

We provide all of the above to ensure the child doesn't just receive one but a selection of toys at Christmas, presented in a festive red sack with the child's name on.

The above items are selected to engage the child in reading, playing games outdoors and bringing families together playing board games.
