Operation Christmas Child and The Toy Appeal

This year, as always, we will be supporting Operation Christmas Child and asking children to donate a shoebox gift for other children across the world. Leaflets are coming home with the children today. This has been our charity of choice for many years and has always been well supported by parents. This year we are offering an alternative to parents who would choose to support a charity without a Christian background, and have chosen The Toy Appeal, based in Knutsford. The Toy Appeal provides Christmas sacks filled with toys and gifts to children across Cheshire and Manchester. I have put together a little information flier which is attached to the end of week email giving more information about the items that they currently need. Recipients of the gift sacks are nominated by schools, social care, charities and drop-in centres and they, like the shoe boxes, are put together to reflect a child's age and gender. If you choose to donate an item for a gift sack, please attach a post-it or small label which can be easily removed indicating what the gift is and which gender / age range it is suitable for. We will collect the gifts and arrange for them to be collected by the charity at the end of November.
