Hygiene

We have been working very hard with the children in Class 2 recently to support them with hand washing and basic hygiene awareness, as we have had a few cases of threadworms. They are very common and parents can find out more here <https://beta.nhs.uk/conditions/threadworms/>

There are some very simple and effective ways that families can help to contain the spread of threadworms including keeping children's nails short, helping them to develop and maintain good handwashing habits after using the toilet, discouraging children from sucking fingers / thumbs / biting nails / sucking toys. One of the best times to check your child is while they are warm and sleeping. Treatment for the whole family can be bought over the counter at the pharmacy.

School Sport Update

On Tuesday we were absolutely delighted to be notified that we have been awarded the Platinum School Games Mark. Only schools who had been awarded the Gold Games Mark for the last five years consecutively were invited to apply via the submission of a detailed case study. Of the 24,000+ schools in England, only 104 schools have been awarded the Platinum Mark, so we are part of an exceptionally elite group. In the whole of the Macclesfield cluster of schools which includes all of the primaries and secondaries in Macclesfield, Poynton and Wilmslow, only ourselves and WHS have achieved the new award. Over the next week I am hoping to work with WHS, Rosie Harris from the Macclesfield SSP, our sports ambassadors and Chris our dodgeball coach (subject of our case study) to organise a high profile celebration event as this is such a fantastic achievement.

We have also had another lovely bonus bit of news for our U11 football team in that, in the absence of an U11s Small Schools qualifying tournament, the organisers of the county finals have decided to take the highest placed small school team from each of the school league tables at this point in the year. For the Wilmslow district, this is our team! The county finals will be in January – further details to follow shortly.
