We are currently rehearsing for the Wilmslow Schools' Music Festival, which will be held on Wednesday 14th March, in the Evans Theatre at the Leisure Centre.

Junior children will walk to and from the Leisure Centre in the morning for the rehearsal of the massed songs.

The performance starts in the evening at 7.00pm, and your child should be brought to the Leisure Centre between 6.30 and 6.45pm (no earlier than 6.30pm). The evening show usually finishes at about 8.00pm. School staff members will be waiting to receive them and will wait with them before the performance starts.

Tickets for the evening cost £4.00 and are available from Mrs Clark (cheques payable to 'St. Anne's Fulshaw Primary School'). We have 98 tickets in total and these will be sold on a one per child basis initially, with spare tickets made available on a waiting list basis from Monday 12th March. If you would like to be put on the waiting list for additional tickets, please let Mrs Clark know by email as soon as possible. Because of the Leisure Centre's fire risk assessment and procedures, absolutely no tickets will be available for sale on the night at the venue, so please make sure that you purchase yours early in order to avoid disappointment.

All children are expected to participate and to wear school uniform on the night. It does get very hot in the theatre, so please could you make sure your child is not wearing their jumper / cardigan during the performance, and is wearing a school logo polo shirt in order to look smart and neat. We are unable to leave clothes in the room where we meet, so parents please keep their coats and jumpers with you.
