Parking

At the start of the school year I'd like to remind parents about the parking arrangements in the school vicinity in order to keep all our lovely children and community members safe. Nursery Lane is narrow and one way. There is street parking further down where there are no restriction lines but please be mindful of our neighbours' access to driveways. There is road parking on Chapel Lane and the surrounding roads but the best place to park is in the car park of The Farmer's Arms pub on Chapel Lane. John has very kindly agreed that parents can use the car park in the mornings and afternoons in order to keep traffic away from the school. This also enables families to walk the last five minutes of their journey to school and to get some fresh air before the day starts. Please, under no circumstances, park on the forecourt of the shops on Chapel Lane, or on Peter Herd's private car park as they are both private property and potential accident blackspots. Use of these two places also causes ill-feeling towards both the school and parents from our neighbours, which we would very much like to avoid. Thank you for keeping everyone in the school community safe.
