

Class 4 and 5 visit to Quarry Bank Mill
Wednesday 20th October

Dear Parents,

As part of our next topic – learning about the changes that took place in the local area during Victorian times – I have arranged for Classes 4 and 5 to visit Quarry Bank Mill on Wednesday 20th October for the day.

Arrangements are slightly different from ‘normal’ school trips, in that we will walk to Styal, and your child will need to be collected from the main National Trust Quarry Bank Mill car park at 2.30pm.

We will leave promptly at 9.00am to walk from school through The Carrs to Styal, which will take us approximately one hour. Children who were apprentices to the Greg family in Victorian times walked to and from St Barts twice every Sunday, so the walk will help us to gain some insight into their lives straight away!

The children will work in classes when we get there, so staying in their bubbles, visiting the mill, and spending time in the Apprentice House. We will be finished by 2.30pm. Children should wear school uniform, and sensible shoes for walking.

Your child will need a water bottle and a waterproof coat, a packed lunch and snacks in a backpack. No money is required on the day, but the trip will cost £8.50 per child.

We are very hopeful that this will go ahead as planned, but if we have to cancel the trip for Covid reasons, we will be able to refund immediately.

We do need to know who will be collecting your child from Quarry Bank Mill, or if they need to be brought back to school for after school club, so please complete the attached slip, and return it to school with the payment as soon as possible.

We are very much looking forward to going on a ‘proper’ school trip again, and we are so lucky to have such a valuable resource for our history learning almost on the doorstep!
