Important information about work starting in your area

Highway Investment Programme – Footway Reconstruction Works – Nursery Lane, Wilmslow.

What is happening

We are pleased to inform you that we will be carrying out footway improvement works on: Nursery Lane, Wilmslow

We understand there is no right time to undertake this work, and the scheme has been carefully planned to minimise disruption.

When it's happening

We plan to start this work on **Monday 18th February 2019** and is scheduled to complete on **Sunday 17th March 2019**.

We will be working between the hours of **8am and 5pm** to ensure that work is completed in line with the proposed schedule. However after the **24th February** the hours will change to **9:30am to 2:30pm** to prevent disruption during school term time.

Under current Health & Safety legislation and for the safety of our workforce **it will be necessary for a road closure to be in place during the works.** 'Business open as Usual' will supplement 'Road Closed Ahead/Diversion' signs.

Whilst every effort will be made to maintain vehicular access to your property/business at all times, due to the nature of the site, it is inevitable that some inconvenience will occur and point of entry may vary. Pedestrian access will be available at all times. Traffic Management Officers are supplied with CCTV cameras and will be present during the works to direct you as the site operations dictate.

Please be kind enough to refrain from parking in the road whilst the work is carried out.

Emergency vehicles will be given access at all times.

What you can expect to see

- Signage mobilised on street in advance of the work starting to notify of the work
- Our team working on the pavements
- Machinery and vehicles
- Barrired areas to create safe working zones, in line with current health & safety legislation
- Some small, intermittent periods of noise
- Pedestrian access, and access to emergency vehicles maintained at all times

Access to your property

We aim to minimise disruption to local residents whilst we deliver these improvements.

We will make every effort to maintain vehicular access to your property, but there may be periods of time when point of entry may vary. If you have any specific access requirements, please raise these with our supervisor on site at the earliest opportunity. Please refrain from parking on, or obstructing the footway whilst the work is carried out.
