### **Free School Meals**

I have attached a letter about free school meals (FSM) to the Flyer email. There are two types of free school meals: infant FSM and income related FSM. All infant pupils (Reception – Year 2) are entitled to FSM currently.

Claiming for income related FSM also triggers a pupil premium payment to school which helps us to support your child's learning. Even if you only claim income related FSM for a short time, the school receives an annual pupil premium payment for as long as your child is in school. We often find that because infant pupils are entitled to FSM, that parents who would qualify for income related FSM don't claim for them. We strongly encourage you to claim them if you are entitled so that the school doesn't miss out on additional funding.
