School Lunches

School Lunches for this half term are £95.00 (38 x 2.50). Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a universal free school meal every day. Once pupils move into Years 3-6, then they need to pay for lunches unless they are entitled to an income-related free school meal. To find out if you are eligible to claim, please call 0300 123 5012 and you will get an instant response.

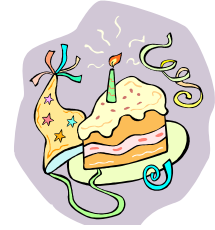
If you are in receipt of any of the following allowances, then you will also be entitled to claim free school meals for your child:

- Income Support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income related Employment Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit - as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) and do not get Working Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit with no earned income or with net monthly earnings less than £616.67

Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, the school receives an additional payment towards supporting their learning if you can claim income-related free school meals, so would encourage EVERYONE who thinks that they might be entitled to this, to claim. Thanks.
