


St Anne's Fulshaw CE Primary School

Dear Parents and Carers,



Please make sure that you update Mrs Clark in the school office if you have a change of e-mail address or mobile number, including numbers for your emergency contacts. Our school Twitter feed is @stannesfulshaw and each of the classes now have their own feeds which I'm sure you have enjoyed reading and responding to.



Please remember to give the school at least one week's notice if your child decides to change from packed lunches onto school lunches or back the other way. Cash or cheques are welcome – cheques payable to Cheshire East Borough Council please. We cannot bank cheques for lunches if they are addressed to the school address rather than CEC's so they will be returned and alternative payment requested. Don't forget that our menus are also available on the school website so children can see what is on offer each day.

Lunches and snacks should not contain crisps, chocolate or sweets. Healthy snacks are available from our cook Janis at a cost of 20p per day. Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school every day. Water is available to the children all day and we encourage them to drink when they need to.

Sunhats and sun-cream are also essential this time of year and we are very happy for children to bring their own sun-cream into school to top up during the day.

Just a few uniform reminders as we head into the summer months:



- School shoes should be black, no trainers or open toe sandals please (these have a habit of tripping pupils as they are running around at playtimes, and of course don't protect their toes while they are climbing or playing)
- Girls' socks should be white and boys' socks should be grey
- Girls may wear checked or striped green and white school dresses in the summer months and boys may wear grey shorts
- Only stud earrings should be worn and these should be removed or covered for PE
- Girls with long hair should have it tied up every day with a plain bobble, this really helps to halt the spread of head lice. Please do not wear ornate flowery clips and hairbands
- All uniform should be named. Unnamed lost property will be disposed of termly or sold as second hand uniform
- All children should have the correct PE kit in school. Children will not be permitted to borrow or share kit for hygiene reasons and will miss both their PE lesson and a playtime if they do not have the correct clothing in school
- Nail varnish or make up is not permitted

Safeguarding

School staff have a statutory duty of care to safeguard pupils and we work closely with a wide range of agencies to ensure that children at risk are identified quickly and well supported.
