We discussed that we weren't keen to do cake sales this year.

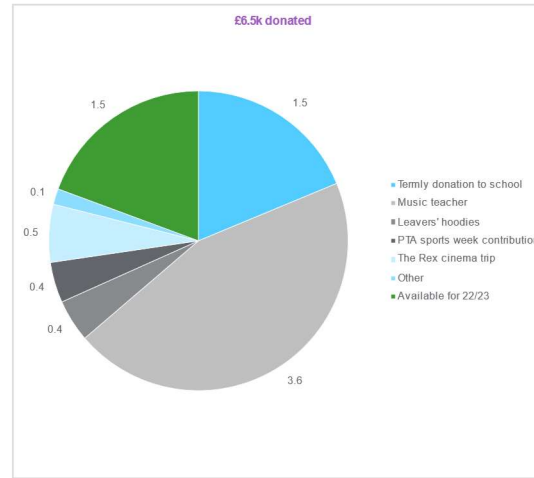
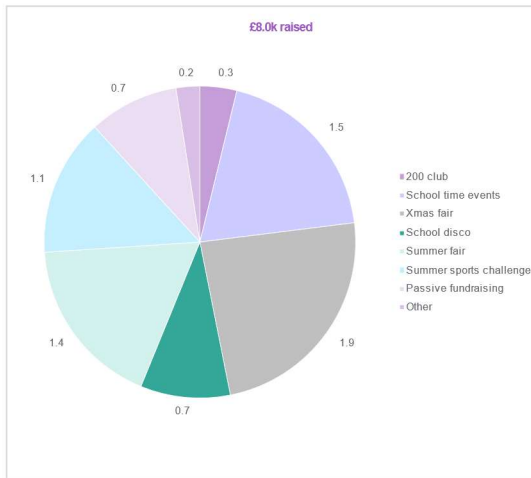
Events that could also be organised: Ladies Night (Laura Walters to look into this), Golf Day, Padel event, Football tournament?
