Finances

The PTA currently hold £12,317, and following the conversation tonight £6,000 has been committed to the funding request from the school leadership.

This is committed as follows:

£10,721 remains outstanding to meet the full amount of the quotation – Clare will be looking at what can be covered off from the various pots school has access to to chip at the total.

Once Clare has fed back what remains to be raised, Gileng will approach Wilmslow Round Table for a contribution, and most of the money raised at the remaining school events for the year will also go towards this.

The PTA aims to always have £6.5k in the bank account which represents a full year of committed costs to enable the normal running of school life – this ensures we always have a year's grace to meet our obligations to school.
