Cheshire East Family Hubs are a one-stop-shop for families with children and young people aged 0-19 (or up to 25 for children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities). We bring the very best of council, health, and community services together.



Our hub journey is broken down into three key steps; Start for life (0-5), Primary (5-11) and Young Persons (11-19).

The Start for Life Journey includes family play sessions which are free of charge and operate on a drop-in basis. Babies Together (0-1yr), Stay and Play (0-5yrs) and our Little Stars group for children with additional needs (0-11yrs) run at each of our Hubs. Families can

socialise, seek advice from our Start for Life Portage Practitioners and meet with Health Visitors as well as being directed to mental health services.
