Educational Visits

It is the aim of our school that all educational visits offered should enhance the curriculum, enriching the children's knowledge and understanding.

Parents will be notified in a letter of the details and asked to make a voluntary contribution, worked out with a view to covering the complete cost, ie. coaches, insurance, entrance fees etc. No visit is profit making.

The law forbids any child to be refused permission to go on educational visits, even if parents do not contribute, it follows that unless everyone does send their donation the visit may be in jeopardy. The final decision will rest with the Headteacher.

Any parent known to have financial difficulties may be invited to discuss the matter with the Headteacher so that an appropriate solution based on individual circumstances can be made.

School Meals

The children pay their lunch money in to the school office on a daily, weekly or termly basis. Some pupils may be eligible for free school meals. Information on how to apply for these is available from the school office and is regularly publicised by the school through the Friday Flyer and email.

School Lettings

The school does not currently let any part of the grounds or premises. If that should change, the school would be advised by the LA's guidance on policy and charges for lettings.
